

**PUBLIC NOTICE  
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO DEVELOP RULES FOR  
NEW MEXICO ENERGY, MINERALS AND NATURAL RESOURCES DEPARTMENT  
OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION**

The New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department (EMNRD), Oil Conservation Division (OCD) is amending its Request for Proposals (RFP) seeking a provider to develop and support the adoption of rules to regulate the venting and flaring of methane at oil and gas facilities.

In light of the declared public health emergency in New Mexico, the amendment requires electronic filing only of proposals and protests at specified email accounts. All other terms and conditions of the original RFP, as previously amended, remain the same.
