Re: Release of Financial Assurance for
Jersey Lily, Snowflake and Virtue Mine Permit, GR008RE

Freeport-McMoRan Tyrone, Inc. (Tyrone) requested a release of financial assurance (FA) of Permit No. GR008RE for the Jersey Lily, Snowflake, and Virtue (JLSV) Mines on January 8, 2013. This letter responds to a letter from MMD dated February 8, 2013 requesting additional information and fees for the release of FA. In 1999 the Mining and Minerals Division (MMD) approved the closeout plan for these mines and associated financial assurance (FA) in the amount of \$46,600. The mines are located on the south side of the Little Burro Mountains in Grant County New Mexico, within a few miles of the Tyrone Mine.

On February 8, 2013 the MMD responded to the application by assigning a modification number (Modification 13-1) and requesting:

- the application fee (19.10.2.201.H),
- proof of public notice (19.10.12.1210.A(3)), and
- description of the closeout measures (19.10.12.1210.A(2))

The closeout measures were described along with a detailed description of the vegetation survey submitted January 8, 2013 with the FA release request.

The following information is provided in in response to MMD's letter and questions sent on February 8, 2013 (numbering in accordance with MMD's points).

1. In the search for rip rap in 2006, Tyrone built a road and drill pad in which a small part (0.11 acres within permit boundary and 1 acre along the mine road) intersected the reclaimed Virtue Mine site.

All of 2006's disturbed areas were reclaimed and seeded in 2007. As noted in MMD's February 8 letter, all corrective actions were completed and the photos cited below show the successful results associated with this corrective action including elimination of the referenced erosion gully. Tyrone disagrees that this tiny area should be excluded from FA release.

Since the disturbed area at Virtue Mine was a minor disturbance area (4.8% of total disturbance area, 1.11 acres out of 23 acres), this disturbance is inconsequential to the overall site. Photos from 2010, 2011, and 2013 of the disturbed area show adequate vegetation (see Appendix A: Pictures 8, 15, 16, 18, 19, and 20). This particular area was included in the 2012 monitoring and exceeded the vegetation success criteria specified in the permit. Because this area meets the success criteria and is so small that it is practically insignificant, Tyrone disagrees that it should be excluded from FA release. It is not necessary to retain the small amount of FA corresponding to this inconsequential area (corresponding to \$2,220 of the overall FA). Maps of the area corresponding to the 2006 disturbance are attached in Appendix B that illustrates the size of this area in the context of the overall sites.

2. The JLSV Mine's application fee for a permit modification is attached in Appendix C.
3. The proof of public notice is attached in Appendix D.
4. Jersey Lily and Snowflake Mines cover an area of 11.9 acres, Virtue Mine covers an area of 5.3 acres and the mine roads cover 6.1 acres (see Appendix B's maps). Reclamation at JLSV Mines was started and completed in 2001 with the closure of three shafts, seven adits, three waste stockpiles, three mine roads, one stope opening, and seeding of all impacted areas. These reclamation activities successfully addressed all existing safety issues. The reclamation on these sites meets the MMD vegetation success standards required by Section 8.F, GR008RE Revision 95-1 at the end of the 12 year monitoring period.

The mine openings were blasted and/or backfilled, bat-compatible metal barriers were installed and the waste dumps and mine roads were vegetated to achieve a post-mining land use of wildlife habitat.

The construction at Jersey Lily consisted of closing two adits and one shaft with bat grates, partial seeding of a waste stockpile (majority of the waste stockpile had naturally revegetated prior to reclamation activities), and ripping and seeding the mine road.

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The construction at Snowflake Mine consisted of blasting and filling of three adits and one shaft with waste material, seeding of a waste stockpile, and ripping and seeding the mine road.

The Virtue Mine had one shaft and one adit blasted shut, one adit closed with bat grates, covering waste stockpile with local soils and seeded, and the stope was filled in. The Virtue Mine and surrounding area (including a mine road) were also vegetated.

The above construction activities were completed in 2001. Two water bars were installed in 2006 on the mine road to Snowflake Mine. The installation of water bars was a normal maintenance activity triggered by a site inspection and the area was interseeded.


The JLSV Mines have been monitored for erosion since 2001. The vegetation was monitored in 2007 and every 3 years after along with monitoring two consecutive years prior to requesting bond release (2011 and 2012). All results were submitted to MMD as required by Permit No. GR008RE.

In 2011, JLSV Mines had 49% canopy cover and 2012 had 40% canopy cover which exceeds the required canopy cover requirements for this site for two consecutive years of vegetation monitoring. The 2012 monitoring data included the former drill pad. These results show that a self-sustaining eco-system has been achieved at the JLSV Mines as required by New Mexico Mining Act (Section 69-36-11(B)).

Based on the vegetation monitoring results, Jersey Lily, Snowflake and Virtue Mine have successfully achieved the twelve year vegetation success standards on 23.3 acres and met the requirements for vegetation release. Photos and maps of the reclaimed areas are provided in Appendices A and B respectively.

Currently Tyrone holds \$46,600 in FA for the JLSV Mines and requests full FA release of 23.3 acres bringing the new FA required to \$0. Tyrone seeks to terminate the Irrevocable Letter of Credit for JLSV Mines.

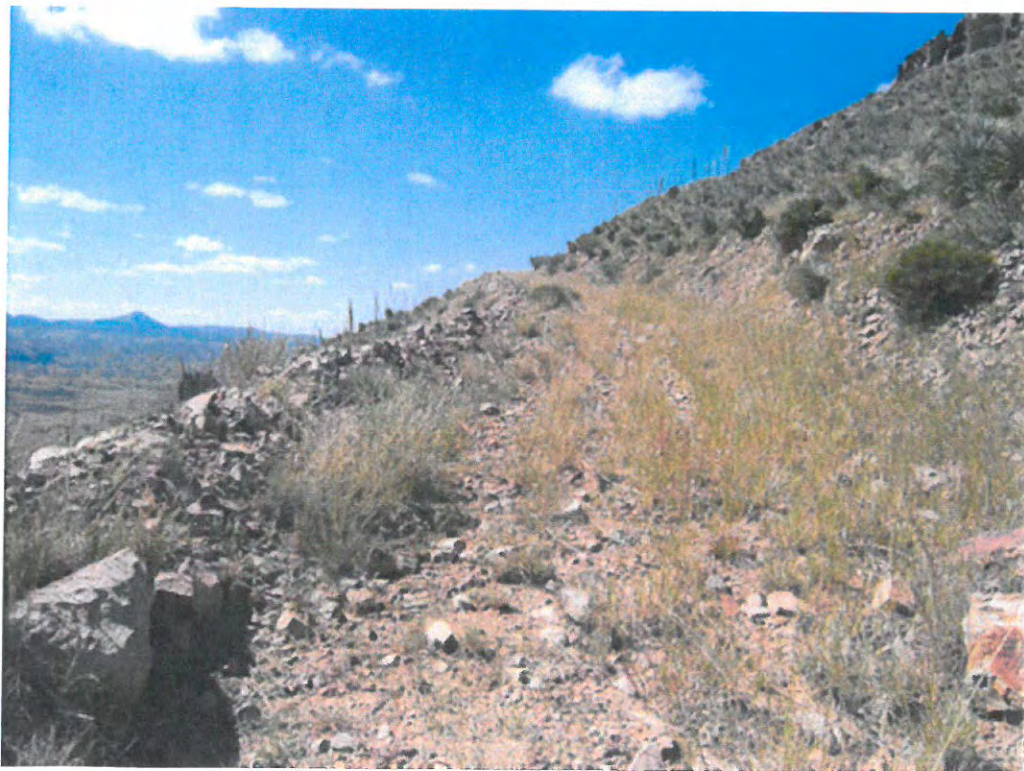

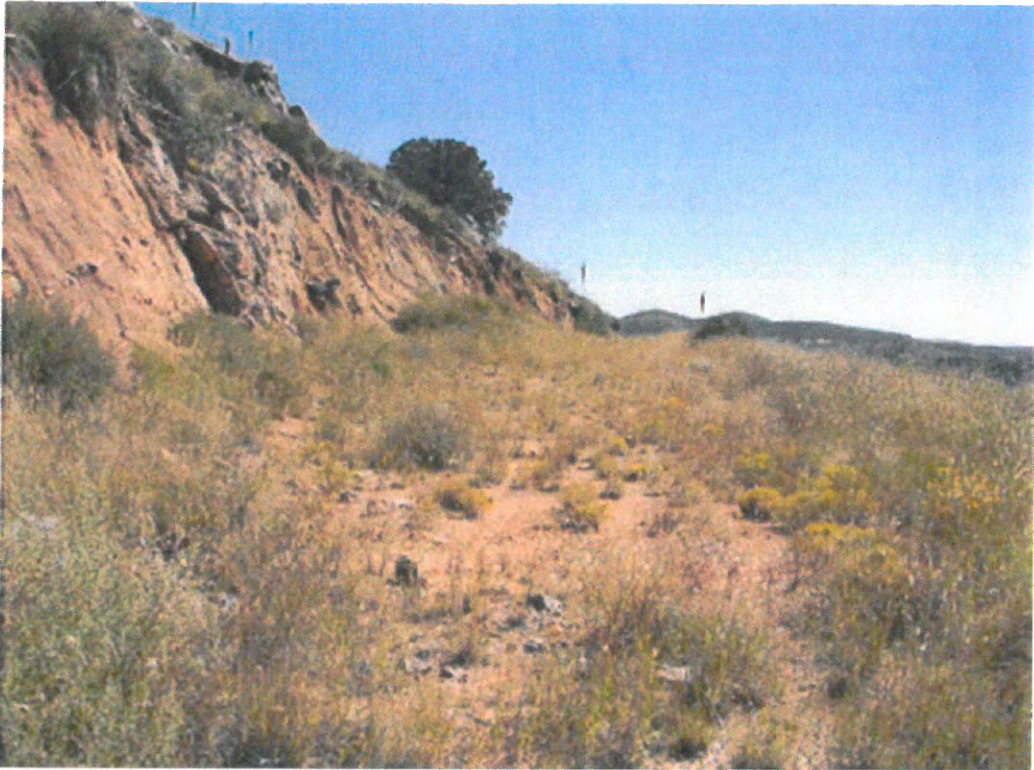

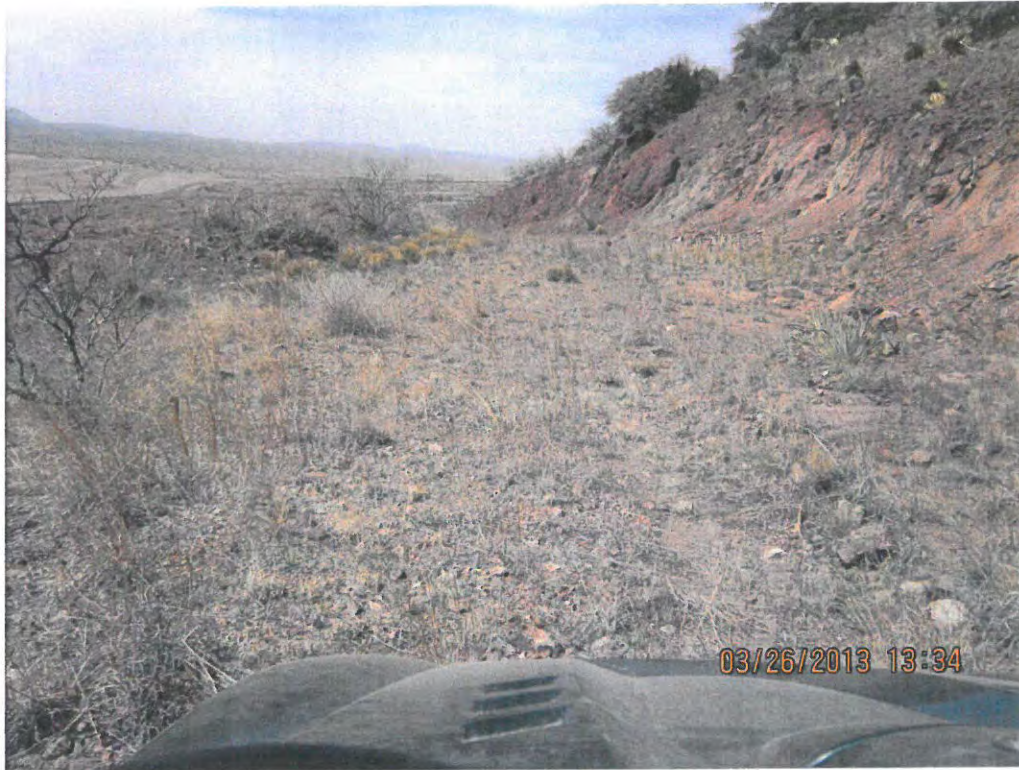

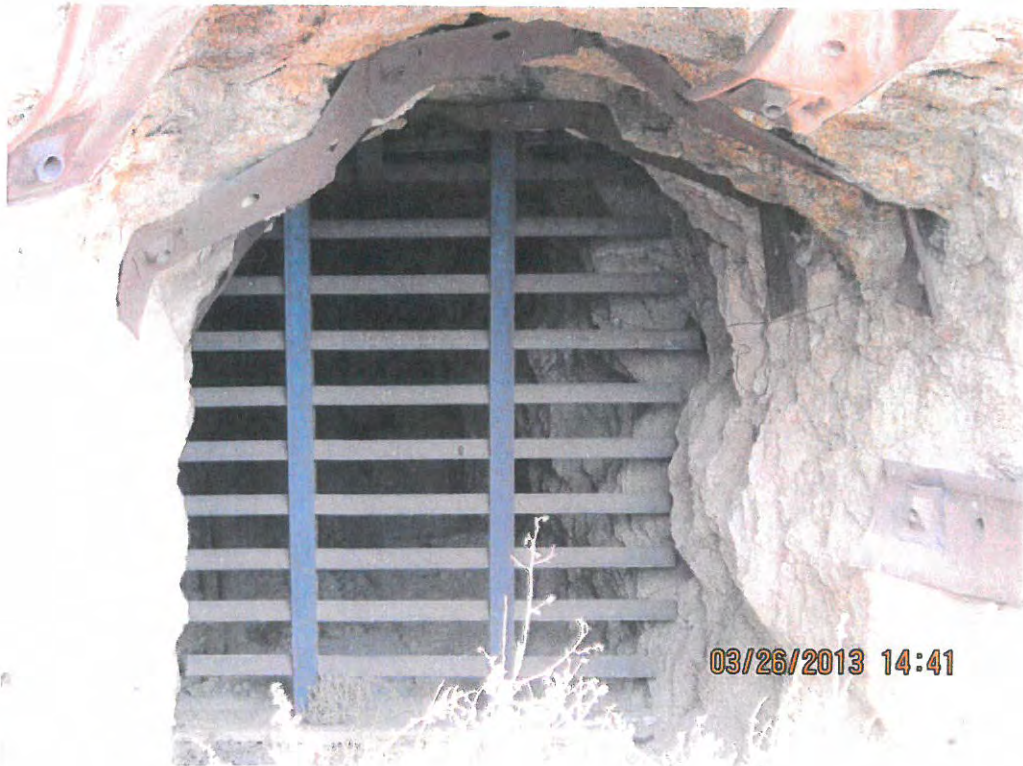

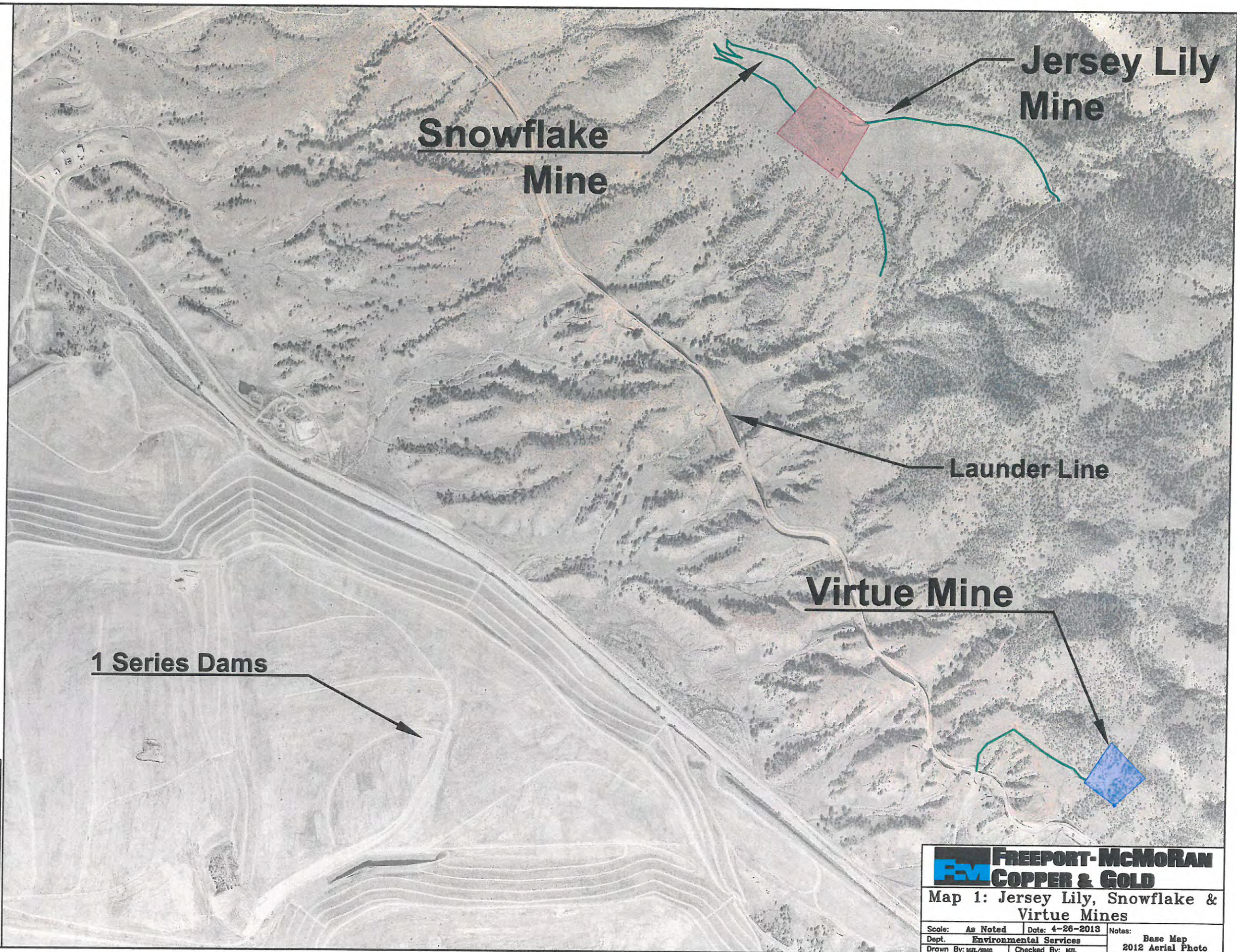

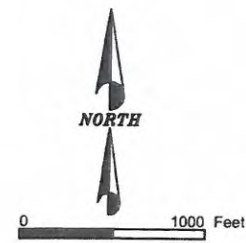

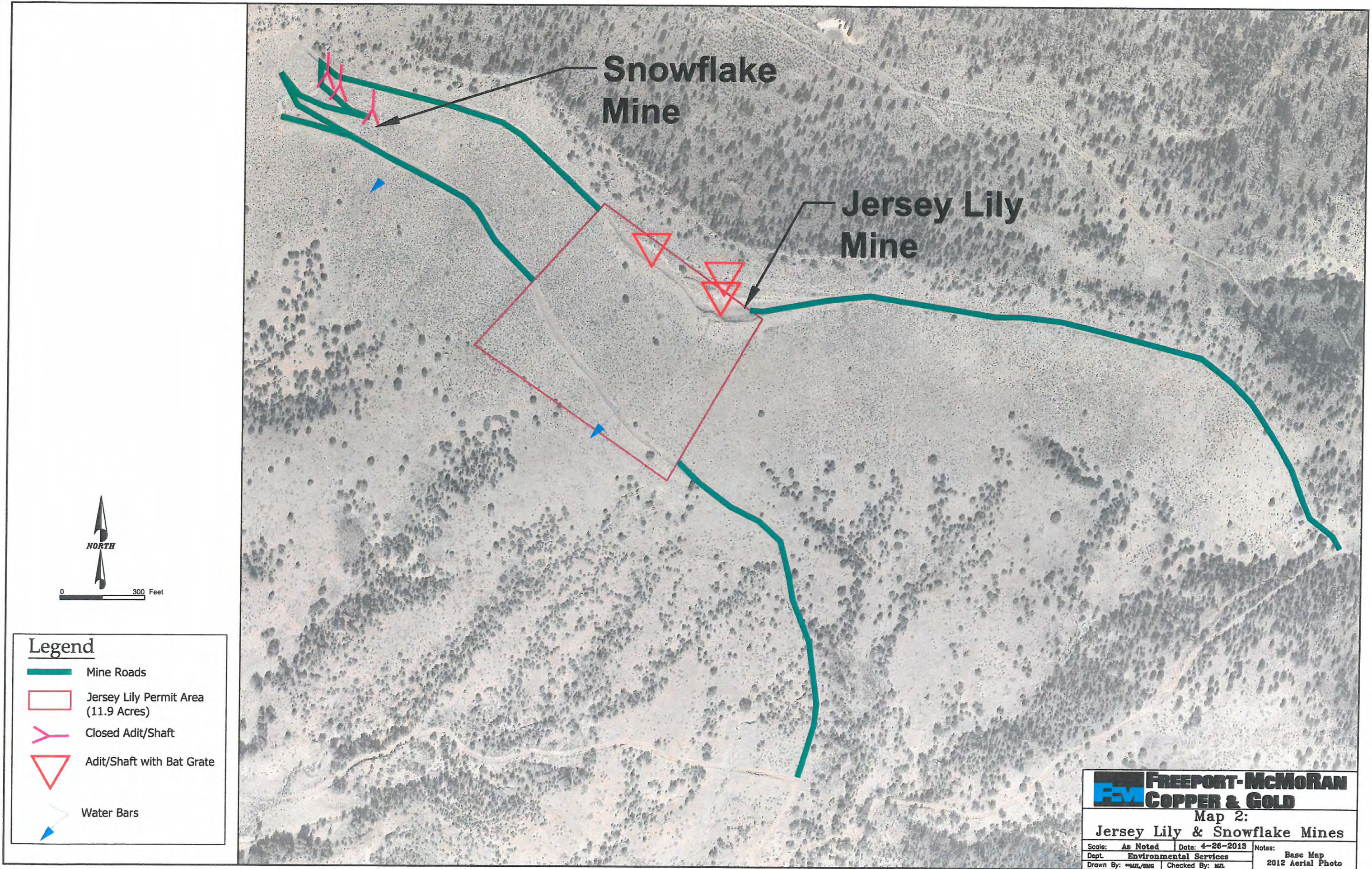

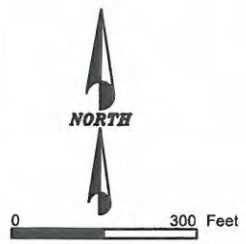
Map 1: Jersey Lily, Snowflake & Virtue Mines

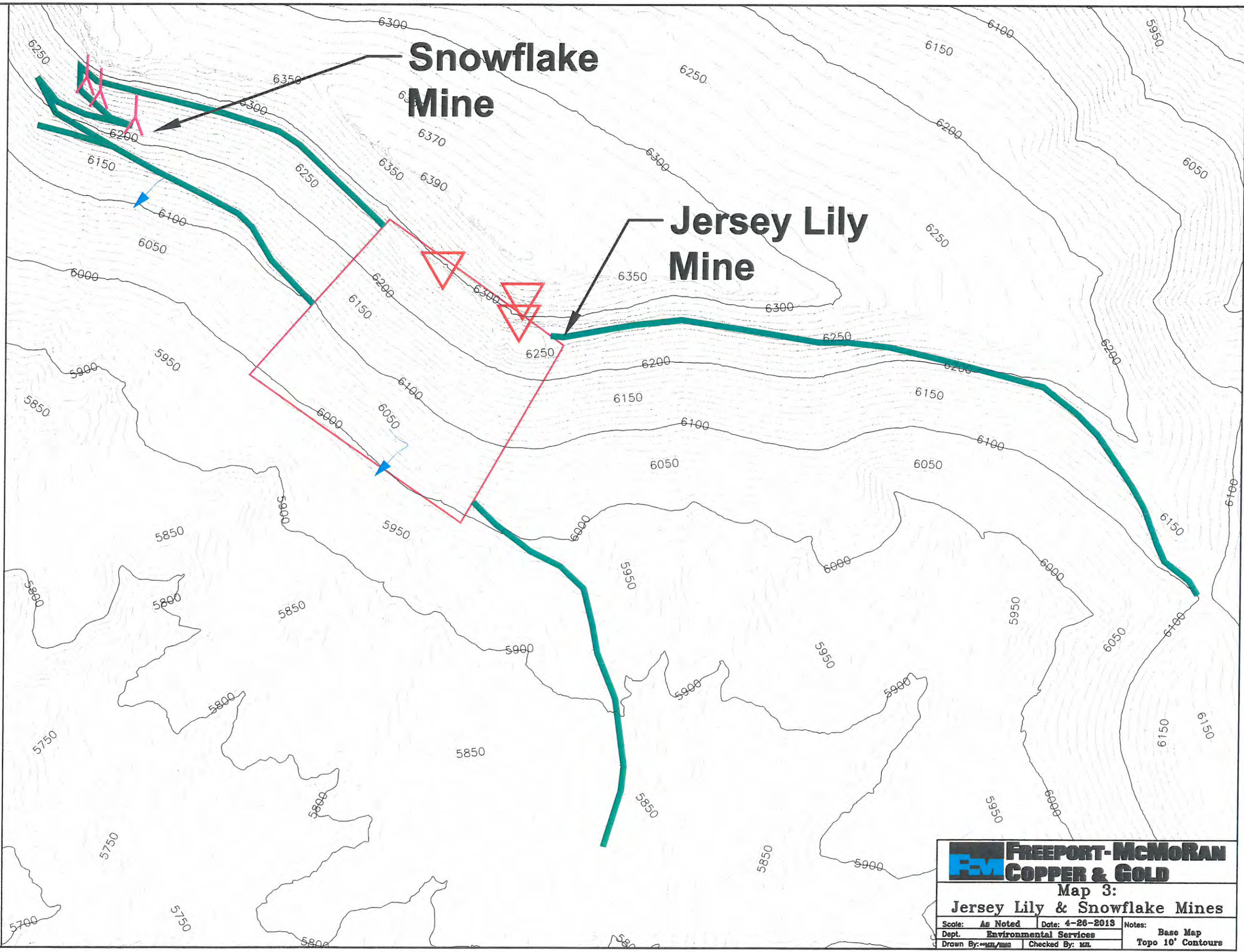

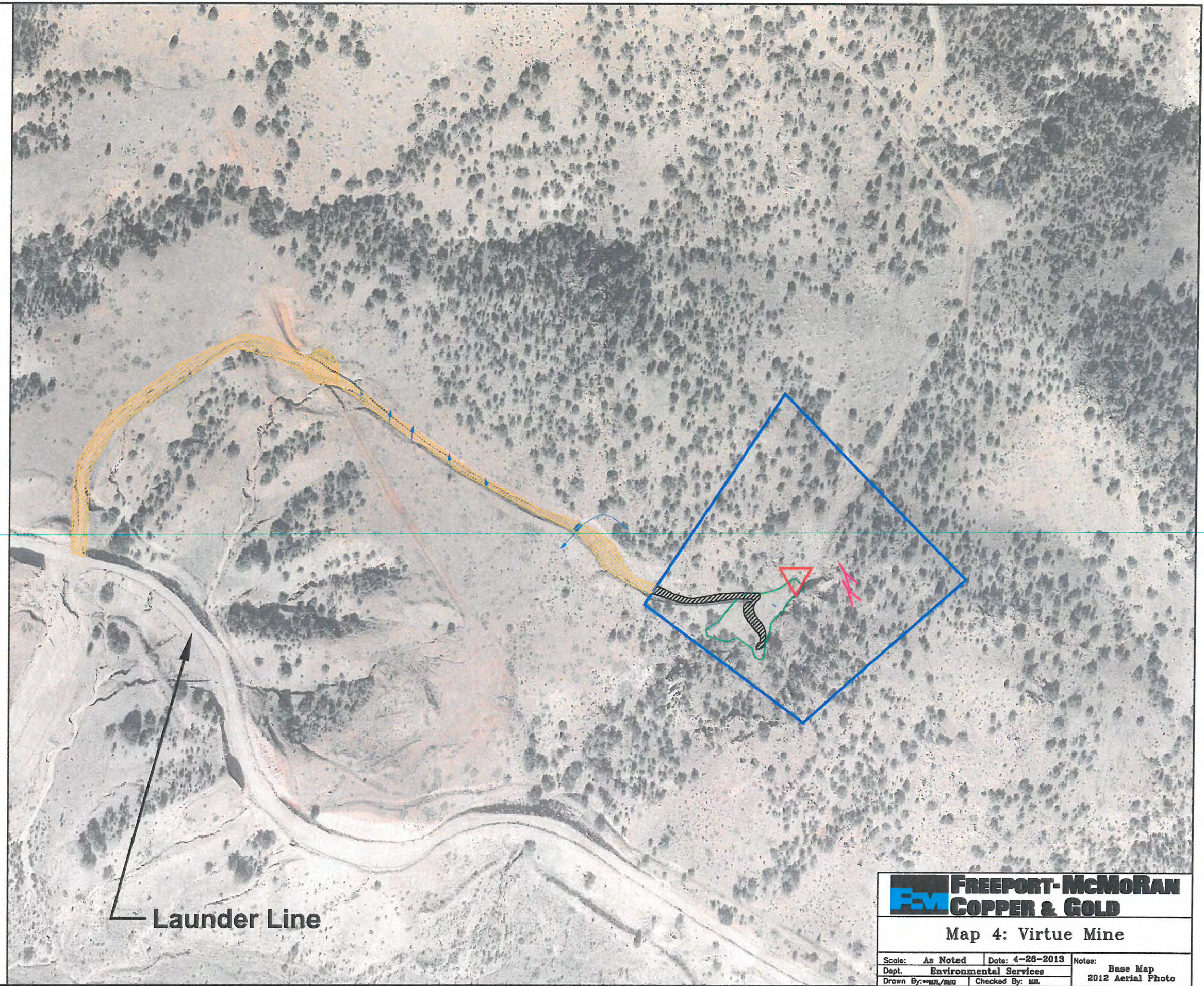

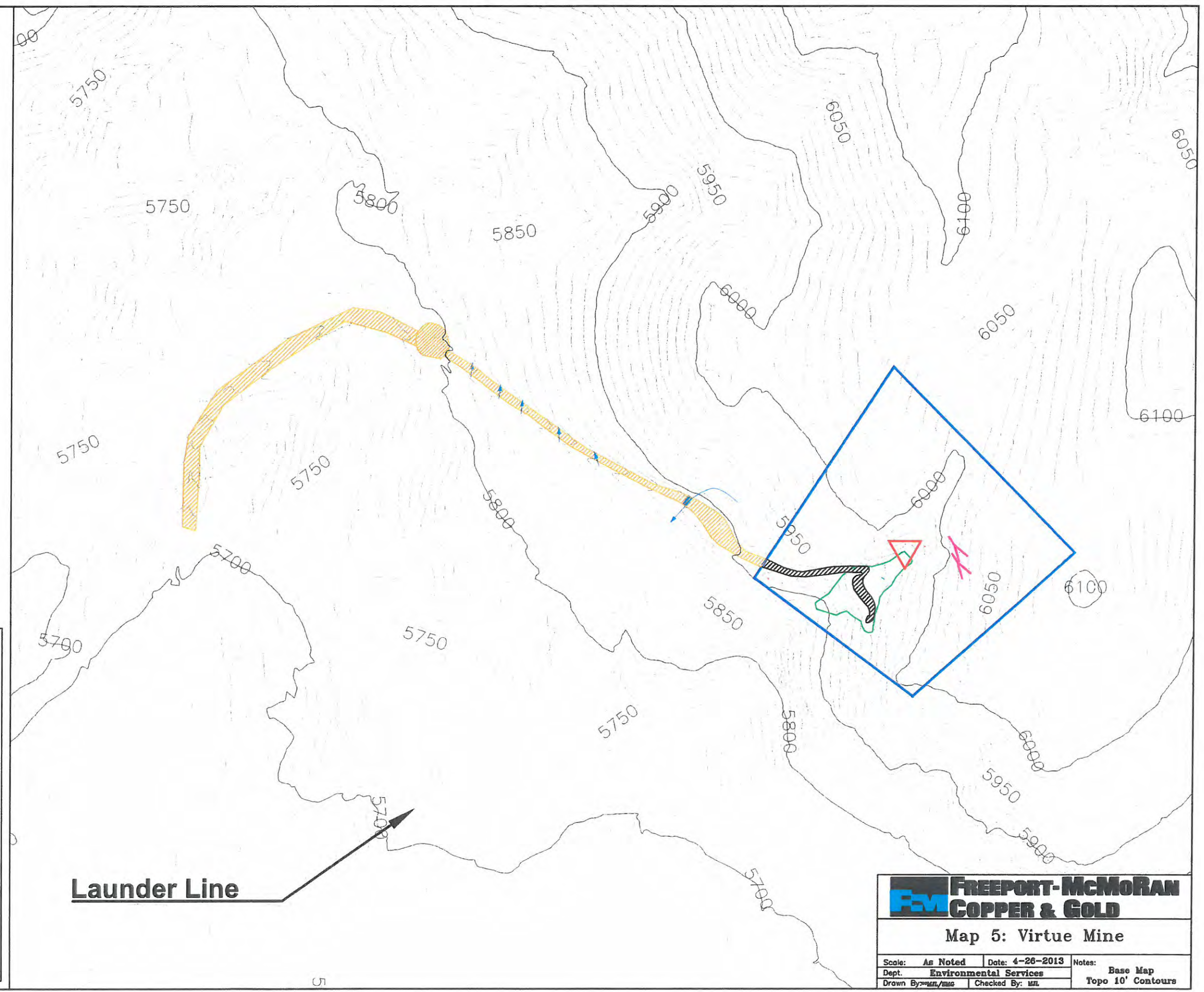
Map 4: Virtue Mine

Location of Real Property Affected: The successful revegetation completed in connection with this application is on Tyrone property in the vicinity of the Tyrone Mine (10 miles south of Silver City, Grant County, NM) at the Jersey Lily, Snowflake, and Virtue Mines (JLSV) which are located within Township 19 South, Range 13 West, Sections 26 and 27 and Township 19 South, Range 13 West and Sections 2 and 3. The mines are located and partially visible on the east side of Moggon Valley Road (~3.5 miles north-south of Tyrone Mine).

Type of Reclamation/Restoration, Parkland, Open and Other: The JLSV Mines consist of 22 acres of reclaimed land which were successfully revegetated to 3001. An access road leading to Virtue Mine was also reclaimed and revegetated. Since 2001 two successful quantitative vegetation assessments were conducted in August 2011 and September 2012. 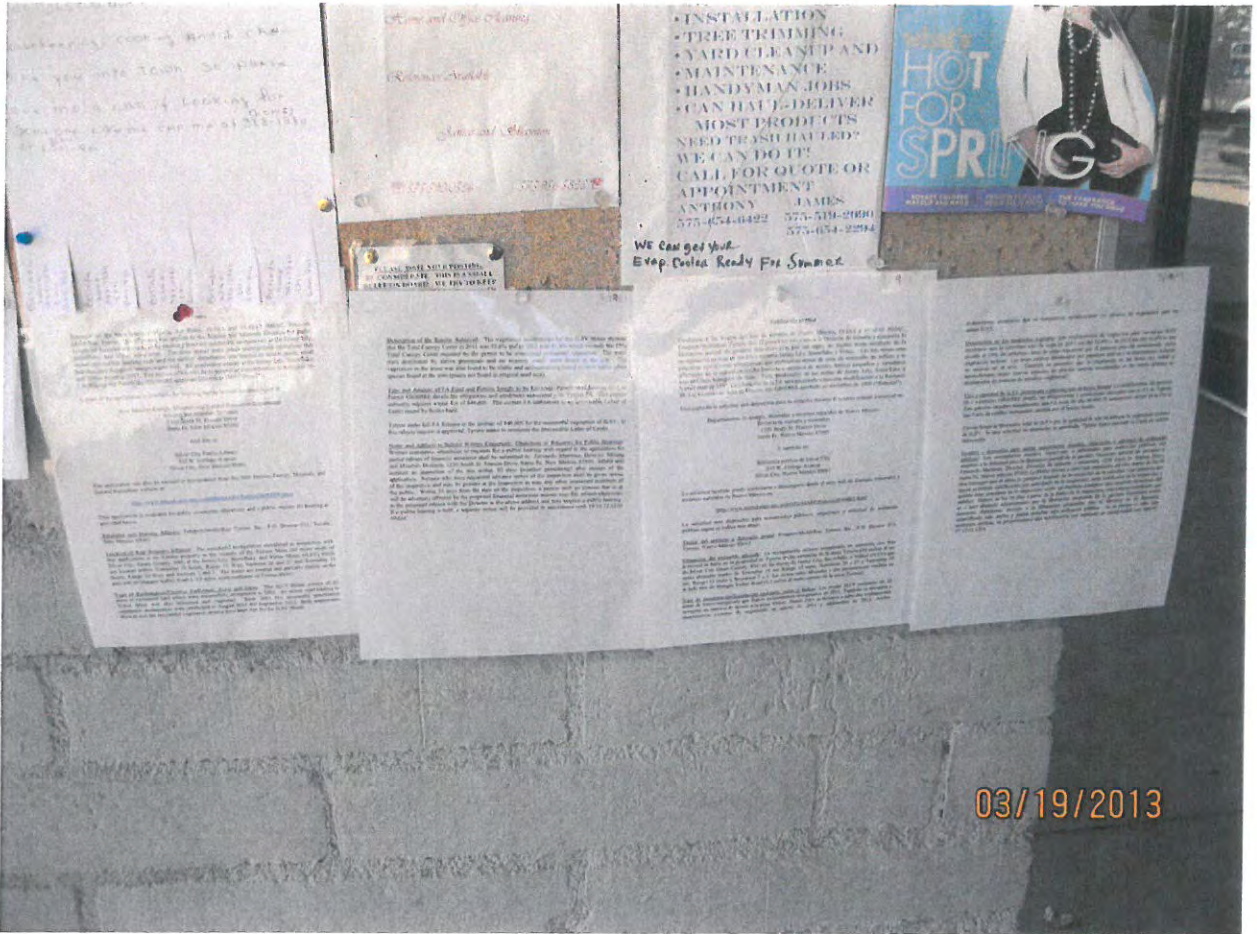
