On October 19, 2016, the New Mexico Mining and Minerals Division ("MMD") received a response from GEO Southwest ("GSW") providing supplemental information and addressing comments that were provided to GSW by MMD in response to a request for additional information in support of GSW's Closeout Plan and Financial Assurance ("FA") Proposal. Additionally, on December 7, 2016, GSW provided MMD with a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment ("ESA") in support of real estate collateral being pledged by GSW as an FA mechanism pursuant to 19.10.12.1208.C NMAC.
