Dear Mr. Thompson:

In regard to your letter to Gulf Coast Mining Group, LLC (hereafter "GCMG"), dated March 22, 2018, the following are the relevant responses in the order set out in your letter:

- 1. GCMG agrees to the change from 9.12 acres to the set out 6.7 acres in its permit modification.**
- 2. GCMG agrees to keep the area of disturbance of the mining operation to the existing 6.7 acres.**
- 3. GCMG agrees not to bring any more ore material from the upper stock pile across the BLM strip of land until it obtains a BLM permit.**
- 4. The final assurance held by MMD is now in place as required.**
- 5. GCMG agrees to pursue a permit from the BLM for all mining and infrastructure-related disturbance that currently exists due to this mining operation and to reclaim such areas in the same manner as described in its existing MMD permit.**
- 6. GCMG agrees to expand its MMD permit area boundary to encompass such associated BLM-disturbed areas once the BLM permit is approved.**

Also, please find enclosed a check in the amount of \$250.00 for the required permit modification fee.
