The Upper Pecos Watershed Association (UPWA) hereby requests that a public hearing be conducted on the application of Comexico LLC to drill up to 30 exploration holes on unpatented mining claims located on public lands in the Jones Hill area of Santa Fe County. Access to this area is provided by NM Highway 63 at the junction of Indian Creek in San Miguel County in the Pecos River Canyon.
