The New Mexico Mining and Minerals Division ("MMD") received *Banner Mine and Mill Site Renewal Application for Standby Status Permit Revision 20-1; Permit Number HI001RE* ("draft application") for review on March 13, 2013. Thank you for your patience with our review of this document. Below are MMD's comments on this submittal per §19.10.7.701 NMAC.

- 1. The content of draft application per §19.10.7.701 (B) NMAC is in an acceptable format.
- 2. Please provide drafts of the public participation notices per §19.10.7.701 (C) NMAC for MMD's review within 30 days of receipt of this letter.
- 3. Per §19.10.7.701 (G) NMAC, MMD will require an updated Closeout Plan with associated Financial Assurance ("FA") prior to approving Standby Status for the Lordsburg Banner Mill; Permit No. HI001RE. In order to incorporate these items into the Revision 20-1 Application, please submit an updated Closeout Plan with the final Revision 20-1 Application within 90 days of receipt of this letter. After the Revision 20-1 Application is deemed Administratively Complete and the scope of work in the Closeout Plan is accepted by state agencies Pyramid Peak Mining, LLC shall submit a FA proposal no later than 30 days from that date.
- 4. According to MMD's Mine Registration and Reporting Program, The Banner Mine and Mill Site last reported production in 2013. This will require that the Banner Mill Standby Status Permit Application Rev. 20-1 reflect a start date of 2014 for the 20-year Standby Status limitation Per §19.10.7.701 (A) and (I) NMAC.
