WestLand Resources, Inc., is sending this letter on behalf of BHP Mineral Resources, Inc. (BHP), to request extension of the minimal impact exploration drilling permit no. GR084EM for the Oak Grove exploration drilling project in Grant County, New Mexico. BHP has completed drilling and borehole abandonment procedures, but at this time is unable to complete reclamation and reseeding due to COVID-19 travel restrictions. The current permit term expires on February 20, 2021.

BHP respectfully requests that you extend the permit term for 1 year. Upon the loosening of travel restrictions and BHP's ability to reschedule the reclamation and reseeding work, they will inform you of their plans to complete that work in 2021.
