Pursuant to §19.10.3.302 NMAC, the New Mexico Mining and Minerals Division (“MMD”) has determined that a Minimal Impact Exploration Permit Application (“Application”) submitted on March 12, 2021, is administratively complete. The application was submitted by WestLand Resources on behalf of Summa Silver Corp. for its Mogollon project and proposes to explore for gold and silver on private, patented mine claims north of Mogollon, New Mexico. The application proposes to disturb less than 5 acres, therefore MMD is processing this application as a minimal impact exploration permit pursuant to §19.10.3.302.A NMAC.

MMD is hereby notifying Summa Silver Corp. that the application is administratively complete. MMD will distribute the application to other cooperating state and tribal agencies to begin technically reviewing the application pursuant to §19.10.3.302.G NMAC.
