The New Mexico Mining and Minerals Division ("MMD") received an application to revise Permit No. SF002RE Cunningham Hill Mine on October 9, 2020, from John Shomaker & Associates, Inc. ("JSAI") on behalf of LAC Minerals (USA) LLC ("LAC") titled, "Cunningham Hill Mine Reclamation Project Closure/Closeout Plan Update" ("Application"). The Application, assigned Revision 20-1 by MMD, proposes to update the Closure/Closeout Plan with specific attention to implications of changes to the water level/quality monitoring of the open pit. MMD reviewed the Application and sent technical comments to LAC on April 21, 2021. On May 21, 2021, LAC proposed to submit an Application modification to address MMD's concerns.
