Section 1. MINE LOCATION

The Midnight Mine permit area encompasses portions of Section 1, Township 12 South, Range 9 West in Sierra County, New Mexico as delineated in the Permit Application Package (PAP).

Section 2. FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Applicant is not required to provide financial assurance in accordance with $\text{§} 19.10.3.303.F$ of the rules, because the disturbance is less than two acres.
2. Pursuant to $\text{§} 19.10.8.802.D.(2)$, the applicant agrees to continue to conduct the operations involved in full compliance with the Act, this Part, and the terms and conditions of the original permit and until applicant has obtained a new, revised, or modified permit.
3. Pursuant to $\text{§} 19.10.802.D.(3)$, for existing or new mining operations, the applicant is eligible to receive a permit for new mines in accordance with section 69-36-12.B(5).
4. Pursuant to $\text{§} 19.10.8.802.D.(4)$ and $\text{§} 19.10.2.201.(G)$, the applicant has paid the permit fee of \$250.
5. Pursuant to $\text{§} 19.10.8.802.F$, the applicant has provided notice to the Director of the consummation of the transfer of the permit.

2. Clinton P & Leslie Jo Anderson (husband and wife) are sole owner's and proprietors of the Midnight Mine properties
3. Clinton P & Leslie Jo Anderson do not own, operate or otherwise participate directly or indirectly with any other mining operations within the United States.

At this time we do not anticipate any new mining operations and will remain within the approved closure of the St. Cloud Mining Company granted on September 16 1998.

Hello,

As I mentioned on the phone today, we just need a little bit more information from you for the permit transfer. Below I have included the exact language from the Mining Act Rules and under that a more direct question that we need answered. This information can be submitted by replying to this email.

1. Provide proof to the Director that the transfer complies with the terms of the mineral lease, if any.
i.e., do you own the mineral rights? Do you have a mining claim? Are you leasing the mineral rights from someone else?
2. Disclosure of ownership and controlling interests in the new mining operation.
i.e., are there any other persons or corporations that will be part owner or directing future operations at the Midnight mine?
3. A statement of mining operations within the United States owned, operated or directly controlled by the applicant, owner or operator and by persons or entities that directly control the applicant and the names and addresses of regulatory agencies with jurisdiction over the environmental aspects of those operations and provide a compliance history for those operations and over the preceding ten years.
i.e., do you own, operate, or otherwise participate directly or indirectly with any other mining operations within the U.S.?
