RE: REQUEST FOR MODIFICATION OF PERMIT MK026MN - BLACK SPRING MINE MINIMAL IMPACT MINING OPERATION

Toltec Mesa Resources LLC (TMR), acting on behalf of Menefee Mining Corporation (Menefee), is submitting this letter to request a modification of Permit MK026MN. This request is pursuant to our recent discussions at and your inspection of the Black Spring Mine on December 1, 2022.

This proposed modification includes a commitment to reclaim and reseed approximately 8.2 acres of the current 17 acres disturbance (see attached map). Menefee is currently backfilling the old pit area and recontouring and sloping this proposed reclamation area and expects that work to be completed before the end of the year. This backfilled and recontoured area will then be ripped parallel to the slope contours and reseeded in the late spring or early summer in 2023. At least 30 days before the ripping/seeding is scheduled, a proposed seed mix and estimated seed quantity will be submitted to Mining and Minerals Division (MMD) for their approval.

Menefee proposes keeping the current design limit of the permit at 12 acres. TMR anticipates coordinating and scheduling the ripping and seeding effort with MMD sometime between April 1 and June 30, 2023; and will submit a report after the reclamation is completed and before July 15, 2023.

The permit modification fee of \$250 is being provided under separate cover from Menefee.
