Financial Assurance/Commencement of Reclamation Work Deadlines, Southwest Resources Inc., Section 12 Mine, McKinley Co., NM, Permit Tracking No. MK046RE

## Greetings:

The New Mexico Mining and Minerals Division (MMD) has found Southwest Resources Inc. (SRI), Section 12 Mine, McKinley Co., NM, Permit Tracking No. MK046RE in non-compliance with the *Director's Order of Abatement on Consent (Director's Order)*, signed January 14, 2020, by Empire Trust Inc., Trustee.

Director's Order Section 32 r. states: Submittal to MMD within 60 days of the effective date of this Order, a schedule for completion of all action items in the Reclamation Plan, excluding achievement of revegetative success, to be completed by no later than two years after the approval of the Reclamation Plan by MMD;

A conditional approval for the Final Reclamation Plan was provided by MMD on November 16, 2020. It has been over the two-year timeframe referenced above in Section 32 r, therefore SRI is in violation of the signed Director's Order. Subsequently MMD sent SRI deadline letters on March 23, 2021, and October 15, 2021, to further advance this project. The deadline letter sent on October 15, 2021, required that reclamation work be complete on the site by December 31, 2022. This deadline has also not been met.

Because the deadlines in the above paragraph have not been met, MMD hereby invokes Section 29 of the Director's Order. which states: *In the event that the Responsible Parties fail to abide by the terms and schedule set forth in this Order of Abatement on Consent and the Final Reclamation Plan, the Director may require the Responsible Parties to provide financial assurance in accordance with the Mining Act Rules*.

MMD is prepared to give SRI two options to move forward with this project:

1. Provide a financial cost estimate for MMD approval within 90 days of this letter followed by an

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appropriate financial assurance instrument (e.g. certificate of deposit, surety bond, letter of credit) within 60 days of the cost estimate's approval.

2. Start reclamation on the site within 90 days of this letter with completion of all reclamation activities, with the exception of achieving vegetative success, within 2 years of the date of this letter.

Per the *Director's Order of Abatement on Consent Section 12 Mine, McKinley County, New Mexico*, signed January 14, 2020, SRI shall align all future submittals with the timelines specified in Sections 30 – 36 of the Director's Order.
