Pursuant to Part 19.10.6.605.A of the New Mexico Mining Act Rules the New Mexico Mining and Minerals Division (MMD) has determined that the recently re-submitted Application to MMD on July 15, 2024 for a New Mine Permit, by Laramide Resources is administratively complete. The New Mine Permit Application proposes to disturb up to 16 acres with in a Permit Area of 107 acres of federal surface lands within the permit boundaries proposed for development of an underground Uranium mine located approximately 10 miles north of the town of Grants, in Cibola County New Mexico.
