In an October 2, 2024 letter, the New Mexico Mining and Minerals Division (MMD) provided a notice of inactivity and a pending denial of a permit application for a minimal impact exploration – CN Project (Application) from Sierra Gold and Silver Ltd (Applicant), MMD Permit No. CA028EM, located in Catron County, New Mexico. This Application has been inactive for over a year without responses by the Applicant or his consultant on the agency comment letter from December 27, 2023.

Since more than 30 days has passed since the pending denial and notice of inactivity letter without reply, MMD hereby denies the Application for exploration permit CA028EM.
