- A. Pursuant to §19.10.8.802.B NMAC, there is no public notice requirement for minimal impact permit transfers.
- B. Pursuant to §19.10.8.802.D(1) NMAC, the Applicant currently is not required to provide financial assurance because the site is less than two acres of disturbance.
- C. Pursuant to §19.10.8.802.D(2), the Applicant agrees to continue to conduct the operations involved, in full compliance with the New Mexico Mining Act ("Act"), the New Mexico

- E. Pursuant to §19.10.8.802.D(4), the Applicant has paid the permit transfer fee of \$250.00.
- F. Pursuant to §19.10.8.802.E NMAC, this permit transfer notifies the current Transferor, the Applicant and the owner of the mineral estate (who is also the Applicant), of the Director's findings.
- G. Pursuant to §19.10.8.802.F NMAC, the Applicant has provided notice to the Director of the consummation of the transaction transferring the Jim Crow Mine from Transferor to Transferee.
