The New Mexico Mining and Minerals Division (MMD) is notifying Roca Honda Resources that the recently submitted Mining Operations and Reclamation Plan (MORP) dated May 4, 2026, for the proposed Roca Honda Uranium Mine has been received and is Administratively Complete. The MORP application component is required pursuant to 19.10.6.602(D)(15) NMAC.

Pursuant to 19.10.6.605(B) and 19.10.9.903(I) NMAC, Roca Honda Resources shall, within 30 days of receipt of this letter, give public notice the MORP has been deemed Administratively Complete. Roca Honda Resources shall provide, to the Director of MMD, timely proof that the notice of this determination has been provided to everyone who has indicated to the applicant in writing that they desire information regarding the application, and to a list maintained by the Director of individuals and organizations who have requested notice of applications. MMD will provide the public notice list as an attachment.
