Dear Mr. Clements,

Pursuant to 19.10.3.302 NMAC, the New Mexico Mining and Minerals Division has determined that a Minimal Impact Exploration Permit Application & fee (application) received February 4, 2026 is administratively complete. The application was submitted by North Shore Uranium Ltd., for its North Shore Rio Puerco Exploration Project and proposes disturb a total of up to 4.7 acres of Bureau of Land Management (BLM) property (27 drill holes on 27 drill pads) within the boundaries of claim numbers identified in the application for exploration located approx. 12 miles NE of Seboyetta, NM Sandoval County New Mexico. MMD is processing this application as a minimal impact exploration permit pursuant to 19.10.3.302 NMAC.

MMD will now distribute the application to other reviewing state, federal and tribal agencies to begin technically reviewing the application pursuant to 19.10.3.302 (G) NMAC. MMD has scheduled the inspection date for March 24th.
