Pursuant to 19.10.3.302 New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), the New Mexico Mining and Minerals Division (MMD) has determined that a Minimal Impact Exploration Permit Application (Application) submitted on April 23, 2024 is administratively complete. The Application was submitted by Raymond Irwin for its Copper Flat Exploration 2024 drilling project and proposes 23 drill holes and drill pads to disturb approximately 4 acres of United States Bureau of Land Management (BLM) property and/or Private Patented claims approximately 4 miles North East of Hillsboro, NM. MMD is processing this application as a minimal impact exploration permit pursuant to 19.10.3.302 (A) NMAC.

MMD is hereby notifying you that the proposed Application for Copper Flat Exploration 2024, MMD Permit No. SI061EM is administratively complete.
