Yankee Canyon (coal); Colfax County (e-AMLIS Key: NM000001, PA Name: Franks)	County road has subsidence holes developing in its path, associated with abandoned coal mine beneath it. Plan is to address the road subsidence issue and reclaim abandoned coal waste piles in the area. Construction expected in 2026, pending Colfax County approval. Associated coal mine adits were safeguarded in July 2025.
Madrid Stormwater Improvements (coal); Santa Fe County (e- AMLIS Key: NM935060, PA Name: Madrid Coal Breaker) (State share funds used for water supply portion of this project pursuant to 402(g)(1) of SMCRA)	Engineering designs to address erosion and drainage issues in the town of Madrid soon to be completed. FONSI and Authorization to Proceed complete. Construction is expected to start in fall 2026. The construction of the replacement water tank for fire suppression was completed in July 2026.
Gallup Dog Park Adit Reclamation Project (coal); McKinley County (e-AMLIS Key: NM 000066, PA Name: Sterling (Laguna Circle))	Adit safeguarding caused drainage issues down a slope leading to a dog park. Project will stabilize drainage path. Construction to take place June/July 2026.

Sugarite Gob Pile Maintenance Project (coal); Colfax County (eAMLIS Key: NM000006, PA Name: Sugarite-b)	Project to address excessive erosion on gob piles within Sugarite State Park.
Gallup-Allison Mine Project Phase IV (coal); McKinley County (e-AMLIS Key: NM000069, PA Name: Allison)	Surface depressions may be related to underground coal mine workings. NEPA complete. Investigative drilling is being completed June/July 2024.
