Pursuant to 19.10.5.506 NMAC, the New Mexico Mining and Minerals Division (MMD) has determined that your application received by this office on July 29, 2010, requesting a modification of the Tyrone Mine Waiver, is administratively incomplete. MMD considers the waiver application to be a revision to the closeout plan for the Tyrone Mine.

Pursuant to 19.10.5.505 NMAC, MMD considers the application to modify the waiver, a significant revision to the closeout plan; hence the application will be processed as a revision, addressing the requirements of 19.10.5.505 and 506 NMAC.
