**Re: Little Rock Update to Closure/Closeout
Plan and Reclamation Cost Estimate**

Freeport-McMoRan Tyrone Inc. (Tyrone) submitted an update to the Little Rock Closure/Closeout Plan (CCP) on June 20, 2020. In an email dated February 15, 2022, Tyrone committed to submit an updated Little Rock Closure/Closeout Plan (CCP) by the end of March 2022 based on comments provided. This letter transmits the updated Little Rock CCP.

The updated Little Rock CCP documents are provided herein and replaces all previous copies of the CCP. Below is a summary of the changes made.

- Removal of all scope, costs, and references to: 'CLW Waste stockpile' and the 'removal of the Reclaimed Copper Leach Stockpile'
 - Restored 'Operations and Maintenance' cost for the 'Reclaimed Copper Leach Stockpile'
- Updated Mining and Minerals (MMD) Permit Boundary and Design Limit Boundary in accordance with recent agreements
- Updated CCP to include full build-out configuration of NRW Waste stockpile (consistent with MMD's revision, New Mexico Environment Department, and Bureau of Land Management applications)
- Updated fuel cost per MMD letter dated November 19, 2021.
