LEGAL NOTICE

Pursuant to the New Mexico Mining Act Rules, 19.10.5 and 19.10.9.903.A through H, CR Minerals Company, LLC (CR Minerals) provides this notice of its application to the New Mexico Energy, Minerals, and Natural Resources Department Mining and Minerals Division (MMD) for a revision of Permit No. RA004RE for the Rocky Mountain Mine. The Permit and application describe reclamation provisions and standards subject to the New Mexico Mining Act and Mining Act Rules.

CR Minerals is submitting an application to MMD for the partial release of financial assurance (FA) for portions of the Rocky Mountain Mine where reclamation work has been completed.

Location of real property affected: The Rocky Mountain Mine is located approximately 5.5 miles west of Espanola, New Mexico, off 31-Mile Road, within Sections 33 and 34, Township 21 North, Range 7 East, in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

General description of the operation and proposed changes: The Rocky Mountain Mine is an existing pumice mining operation operated by CR Minerals. Mining and reclamation activities have progressed such that portions of the site have completed reclamation and are eligible for partial financial assurance release. CR Minerals has requested the partial release of reclaimed areas for 14.5 acres of earthwork and full release of 32.3 acres of reclaimed areas that have completed the reclamation requirements within the mining area limits under Permit No. RA004RE.

This application for partial financial assurance release is available for public comment and a public request for hearing as provided below.
