# Closure Activity Update: July 2021

Work priorities continued to focus on demolition projects as RGR awaits approval of the MOD 20-1, Disposal Cell Expansion and Radiological Survey Work Plan. Closure projects have been impacted. Closeout/closure work focused on demolition of MWTU pond hydraulic structures and the Service and Support facilities.

#### **Activities**

- 1) Ore Pile Removal
  - Removal and transportation of the ore pile material continued
  - Approximately 2,304 tons of low-grade ore were hauled off site during the month
    - o To-date hauled: 49,757 tons
- 2) MWTU Ponds
  - Pond 2 remains ready for use
- 3) WP5 Well, MW6 Well and North Force Main (NFM)
  - The WP5 and MW6 wells continued to pump on fully automatic cycles
  - Made preparations to commission the NFM
- 4) Closeout/Closure Activities
  - Demolition:
    - MWTU Pond Hydraulic Structures:
      - Pond 1 (3 structures)
        - Str 1 demolished
        - Str 2 demolished
        - Str 3 not demolished due to risk of damaging Pond 2 liner
        - Anchor Block 30% demolished
      - Pond 4: Completed, all 3 Structures demolished
      - Pond 5 (4 structures)
        - Str 1 demolished
        - Str 2 demolished
        - Str 3 40% demolished
        - Str 4 demolished
      - Pond 6 (5 structures)
        - Str 1 90% demolished
        - Str 2 60% demolished
        - Str 3 not started
        - Str 4 not started
        - Str 5 40% demolished (floor demolished, walls remain)
      - Pond 7 (4 structures)
        - Str 1 60% demolished
        - Str 2 60% demolished
        - Str 3 not started
        - Str 4 not started
      - Pond 8: Complete, all 2 structures demolished

Note: remaining structures were too deep to reach with equipment, will need to remove debris before completing the remaining portions

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- Building Slab Demolition Completed
  - MWTU Pump building and MCC slabs
  - Barium Chloride Building slab
  - Flocculant building slab
  - Fuel Pump building slab
  - Hoist House west transformer pad
  - IX transformer pad and propane tank pad
  - Emergency Generator pad
  - Shaft Sump Clean-out pad floor is 20% demolished
  - Discharge Pipeline thrust block west of Pond 2
- Excavation of process water pipes
  - Began excavating pipes at Ponds 1, 6 and 7
  - Began excavating pipes near the Flocculant building
- Continued removing and sorting equipment, debris and scrap from around the site:
  - o Removed handrailing from around the MWTU pond hydraulic structures
  - o Completed removing equipment and debris from Compressor building
  - o Prepared the Chlorine building for demolition (removed out-of-service equipment)

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5) Other: Held a phone meeting with USFS regarding removal of the discharge pipeline

### Critical Path Items

1) Approval of eastward expansion of the disposal cell

## <u>Delays</u>

- Earth moving projects are delayed until the disposal cell expansion is approved
- Demolition projects are somewhat delayed as RGR awaits approval of the MOD 20-1 and radiological survey work plan
- Deep Aquifer well plugging and abandonment is delayed pending approval of the monitoring plan
