The proposed La Jara Mesa Projectis located on US Forest Service lands approximately 10 miles north of Grants, New Mexico. The permit area includes portions of the SE¼ Section 10, the SW¼ Section 11, the NE¼, Section 15, and the NW¼Section 14, T12N, R9W, Cibola County, New Mexico. Access is via to-be-improved private property roads and US Forest Service roads which connect the project to a point on New Mexico State Highway 605 approximately 5 miles north of the Town of Milan. From Highway 605, the access to the minetraverses to the east across parts of Section24, T12 N, R10W, and the common section line of Sections 19 and 30, 20 and 29, and 21 and 28, T12N, R9W. 

OWNERS WITHIN 1/2 MILE (19.10.9.903A)










