Re: Freeport-McMoRan Cobre Mining Company –
Permit No. GR002RE 14-1, Condition 3.B

Condition 3.B of GR002RE 14-1, Cobre Haul Road, requires Cobre to provide to MMD "an updated Figure indicating all approved design limits for the Continental Mine" within 90 days of approval of GR002RE 14-1.

Cobre's design limits were approved in GR002RE 01-1, Section 3.B, as delineated in the "*Revised Cobre Mining Act Permit Boundary – Drawing 1*", dated December 30, 2004. Pursuant to Condition 3.B, Revision 14-1, please find enclosed an updated "*Drawing 1 – Revised, Approved Mining Act Permit Boundary and Design Limits*" dated February 7, 2017.

Please note the approved design limits in Drawing 1 are an historical approximation to actual mining activities at Cobre's facilities. Cobre will separately address appropriate updates and corrections to the design limits under application GR002RE 15-1 Permit Revision Ending Standby Status.

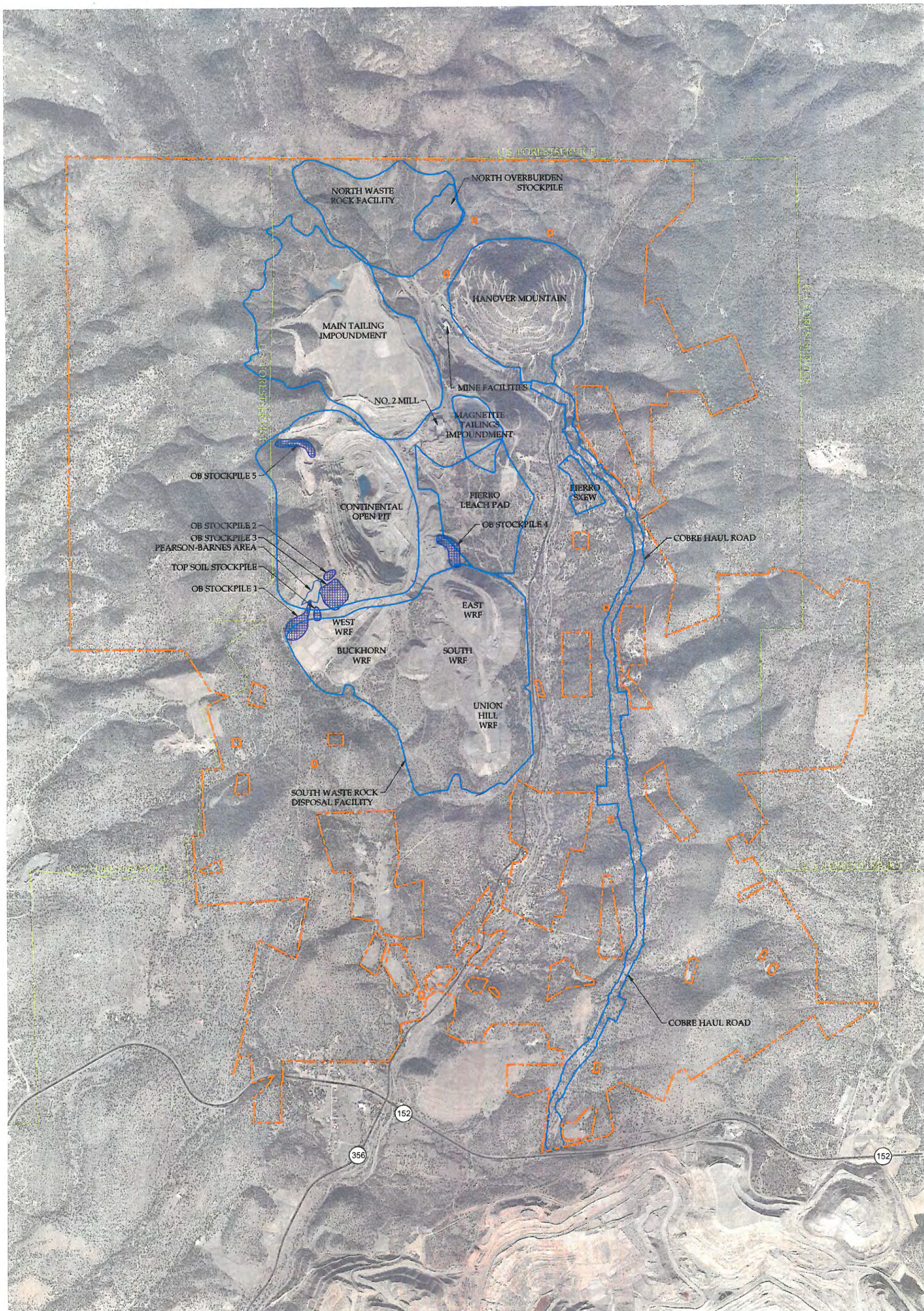
