Pursuant to the Surface Waste Management Facilities Rules (19.15.36 NMAC), notice is hereby given that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“Division”) has received a major modification request to an existing Surface Waste Management Facility permit, which was submitted to the Division on July 30, 2019:

Lea Land, LLC (1300 W. Main St., Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73106), has submitted an application to the Division to modify their existing permit NM1-035 and expand operations at an active commercial Surface Waste Management Facility (“Facility”). The proposed Facility is located approximately 27 miles west-northeast of Carlsbad, New Mexico in Section 32 of Township 20 South, Range 32 East NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. The proposed Facility will consist of approximately 463.37 acres in which approximately 100 acres are proposed for a landfill for the permanent disposal RCRA exempt and non-hazardous oil field waste. Additional proposed auxiliary waste operations include a processing area that may include an oil treatment facility consisting of 9 produced water load-out points, 4 mechanical oil/water separation units, 12 produced water receiving tanks, 48 produced water settling tanks, 12 evaporation ponds, 5 crude oil recovery tanks, 5 oil sales tanks, 1 stabilization and solidification unit, and a 6-bay customer jet wash.
