Pursuant to the Surface Waste Management Facilities Rules (19.15.36 NMAC), notice is hereby given that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“Division”) has received a Surface Waste Management Facility permit application, which was submitted to the Division on June 28, 2019:

NGL Waste Services LLC (3773 Cherry Drive, Suite 100, Denver, Colorado 80209), has submitted an application to the Division to construct and operate a new commercial Surface Waste Management Facility (“Facility”). The proposed Facility is located approximately 16.25 miles west-northwest of Jal, New Mexico in Sections 9 and 10 of Township 25 South, Range 34 East NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. The proposed Facility will consist of approximately 303 acres in which approximately 205 acres are proposed for a landfill for the permanent disposal exempt and non-hazardous oil field waste. Additional proposed auxiliary waste operations include three stabilization/solidification drying pad units, a truck wash facility and a leachate collection evaporation pond for the proposed landfill.
