Pursuant to the Surface Waste Management Facilities Rules (19.15.36 NMAC), notice is hereby given that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“Division”) has received a Surface Waste Management Facility permit application, which was submitted to the Division on June 28, 2019:

NGL Waste Services, LLC (3773 Cherry Creek Dr, Suite 1000, Denver, Colorado 80209) has submitted an application to the Division to construct and operate a new commercial Surface Waste Management Facility (“Facility”). The proposed Facility is located approximately 8.25 miles southwest of Jal, New Mexico in Section 27 of Township 26 South, Range 36 East NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. The proposed Facility will consist of approximately 180 acres in which approximately 112 acres are proposed for a landfill for the permanent disposal RCRA exempt and non-hazardous oil field waste. Additional proposed auxiliary waste operations include three stabilization/solidification drying pad units, a truck wash facility and a leachate collection evaporation pond for the proposed landfill
