Pursuant to the Surface Waste Management Facilities Rules (19.15.36 NMAC), notice is hereby given that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“Division”) has received a Surface Waste Management Facility permit application, which was submitted to the Division on November 25, 2020.

Hilcorp Energy Company (382 County Road 3100, Aztec, New Mexico 87401), has submitted an application to the Division to construct and operate a new centralized Surface Waste Management Facility (“Facility”). The proposed Facility is located approximately 12.7 miles northeast of Aztec, New Mexico in SE/4SW/4 of Section 5 of Township 31 North, Range 9 West NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. The proposed Facility will consist of approximately 37.8 acres in which approximately 17.7 acres are proposed for the remediation of petroleum hydrocarbon-contaminated soils and drill cuttings by the method of landfarming.
