1. Case No. 25972: Application of Marathon Oil Permian, LLC for Approval of a Non-Standard Horizontal Well Spacing Unit and Compulsory Pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order (a) approving a non-standard 479.57-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation underlying Lots 1-4 and S/2 N/2 (N/2 equivalent) of irregular Section 2 and Lots 1-2 and S/2 NE/4 (NE/4 equivalent) of irregular Section 3, Township 24 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, and (b) pooling the uncommitted interest owners in this acreage. Applicant seeks to initially dedicate the above-referenced horizontal spacing unit to the Campana State Com 501H well, to be drilled from a surface location in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of irregular Section 2, a first take point in Lot 1 (NE/4 NE/4 equivalent) of irregular Section 2, to a last take point in Lot 2 (NW/4 NE/4 equivalent) of irregular Section 3; and Campana State Com 502H well, to be drilled from a surface location in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of irregular Section 2, a first take point in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of irregular Section 2, to a last take point in the SW/4 NE/4 (Unit G) of irregular Section 3. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and

completing the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling the wells. The subject area is located approximately 11 miles south of Carlsbad, New Mexico.

2. Case No. 25973: Application of Marathon Oil Permian, LLC for Compulsory Pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interest owner in the Wolfcamp formation underlying a standard 479.57-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit comprised of Lots 1-4 and S/2 N/2 (N/2 equivalent) of irregular Section 2 and Lots 1-2 and S/2 NE/4 (NE/4 equivalent) of irregular Section 3, Township 24 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks to initially dedicate the above-referenced horizontal spacing unit to the Campana State Com 701H and Campana State Com 901H wells, both to be drilled from surface locations in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of irregular Section 2, first take points in Lot 1 (NE/4 NE/4 equivalent) of irregular Section 2, to last take points in Lot 2 (NW/4 NE/4 equivalent) of irregular Section 3; and Campana State Com 702H and Campana State Com 902H wells, both to be drilled from surface locations in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of irregular Section 2, first take points in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of irregular Section 2, to last take points in the SW/4 NE/4 (Unit G) of irregular Section 3. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling the wells. The subject area is located approximately 11 miles south of Carlsbad, New Mexico.

3. Case No. 25980: Application of Coterra Energy Operating Co, for Approving a Standard Horizontal Spacing Unit and Compulsory Pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order from the Division: (1) approving a 639.28-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing and proration unit composed of the E/2 of Sections 3 and 10, Township 24 South, Range 26 East, N.M.P.M. Eddy County, New Mexico, and (2) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the WC-015 G-04 S232628M; Bone Spring formation designated as an oil pool, underlying said unit. The proposed wells to be dedicated to the horizontal spacing unit are the: Cherry Hills 10-3 Fed Com 1H (API No. Pending), which is an oil well that will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 10 Township 24 South, Range 26 East, to a bottom hole location in the WC-015 G-04 S232628M; Bone Spring Pool in the NW/4 NE/4 (Lot 2) of Section 3, Township 24 South, Range 26 East; and the Cherry Hills 10-3 Fed Com 2H (API No. Pending), which is an oil well that will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 10 Township 24 South, Range 26 East, to a bottom hole location in the WC-015 G-04 S232628M; Bone Spring Pool in the NE/4 NE/4 (Lot 1) of Section 3, Township 24 South, Range 26 East; The wells are orthodox in location, and the take points and laterals comply with statewide setbacks for the WC-015 G-04 S232628M; Bone Spring. The wells and lands are located approximately 6.8 miles southeast of Whites City, New Mexico.

4. Case No. 25981: Application of Coterra Energy Operating Co, for Approving a Standard Horizontal Spacing Unit and Compulsory Pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order from the Division: (1) approving a 639.28-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing and proration unit composed of the E/2 of Sections 3 and 10, Township 24 South, Range 26 East, N.M.P.M. Eddy County, New Mexico, and (2) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp formation, designated as an gas pool, underlying said unit. The proposed wells to be dedicated to the horizontal spacing unit are the: Cherry Hills 10-3 Fed Com 3H (API No. Pending), which is a gas well that will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 10 Township 24 South, Range 26 East, to a bottom hole location in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp Pool in the NW/4 NE/4 (Lot 2) of Section 3, Township 24 South, Range 26 East; Cherry Hills 10-3 Fed Com 4H (API No. Pending), which is a gas well that will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 10 Township 24 South, Range 26 East, to a bottom hole location in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp Pool in the NE/4 NE/4 (Lot 1) of Section 3, Township 24 South, Range 26 East; Cherry Hills 10-3 Fed Com 5H (API No. Pending), which is a gas well that will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 10 Township 24 South, Range 26 East, to a bottom hole location in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp Pool in the NW/4 NE/4 (Lot 2) of Section 3, Township 24 South, Range 26 East; and the Cherry Hills 10-3 Fed Com 6H (API No. Pending), which is a gas well that will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 10 Township 24 South, Range 26 East, to a bottom hole location in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp Pool in the NE/4 NE/4 (Lot 1) of Section 3, Township 24 South, Range 26 East. The wells are orthodox in location, and the take points and laterals comply with Special Pool Rules R-14262 setbacks for the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp. The wells and lands are located approximately 6.8 miles southeast of Whites City, New Mexico.

5. Case No. 25982: Application of Coterra Energy Operating Co, for Approving a Standard Horizontal Spacing Unit and Compulsory Pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order from the Division: (1) approving a 1,280-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing and proration unit composed of all of Sections 35 and 36, Township 24 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and (2) pooling all

uncommitted mineral interests in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp formation, designated as an gas pool, underlying said unit. The proposed wells to be dedicated to the horizontal spacing unit are the: Know Whatta Mean 31-36-35 Fed Com 1H (API No. Pending), which is a gas well that will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 26 East, to a bottom hole location in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp Pool in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 25 East; Know Whatta Mean 31-36-35 Fed Com 2H (API No. Pending), which is a gas well that will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 26 East, to a bottom hole location in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp Pool in the SW/4 NW/4 (Unit E) of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 25 East; Know Whatta Mean 31-36-35 Fed Com 3H (API No. Pending), which is a gas well that will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 26 East, to a bottom hole location in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp Pool in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 25 East; Know Whatta Mean 31-36-35 Fed Com 4H (API No. Pending), which is a gas well that will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 26 East, to a bottom hole location in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp Pool in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 25 East; Know Whatta Mean 31-36-35 Fed Com 5H (API No. Pending), which is a gas well that will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 26 East, to a bottom hole location in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp Pool in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 25 East; Know Whatta Mean 31-36-35 Fed Com 6H (API No. Pending), which is a gas well that will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 26 East, to a bottom hole location in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp Pool in the SW/4 NW/4 (Unit E) of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 25 East; Know Whatta Mean 31-36-35 Fed Com 7H (API No. Pending), which is a gas well that will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 26 East, to a bottom hole location in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp Pool in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 25 East; and the Know Whatta Mean 31-36-35 Fed Com 8H (API No. Pending), which is a gas well that will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 26 East, to a bottom hole location in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp Pool in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 25 East; The wells are orthodox in location, and the take points and laterals comply with Special Pool Rules R-14262 setbacks for the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp. The wells and lands are located approximately 2.94 miles southeast of Whites City, New Mexico.
