Case 23580: Application of WildEarth Guardians to Consider the Proposed Amendments to the address Perfluoroalkyl and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances and their use in oil and gas extraction, 19.15.2, 19.15.16, 19.15.31, and 19.15.32 NMAC. This case was continued for April 11, 2024 With the direction from the Commission for the parties to come up with a tentative schedule and updated scheduling order with changed dates and other items relevant to the revised schedule.

<u>Case Nos 24277, 24278 and 23755:</u> Goodnight Midstream Permian, LLC which was a referral to the Commission of a number of Division cases by the director of the Oil Conservation Division. The parties provided a historical review of the cases and core questions at issues. This case was continued for April 11, 2024, with the

direction from the Commission for the parties to come with a tentative schedule for hearing the matter, both as to motion practice on the merits.

Item 5: Cases set for Hearing

<u>Case 23655:</u> Application of the Joint Industry Technical Committee to Amend Order No. R-111-P, Lea and Eddie Counties, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks to amend Commission Order R-111-P, adopted in 1988 under Case 9316, to add anti-collision measures, to modify the well casing and cementing requirements, to provide additional notification requirements to potash operators, to provide for subsidence monitoring, and to adopt other proposed changes for oil and gas development in the Known Potash Leasing Area located in Eddy and Lea Counties, New Mexico.

Action:

The Commission heard evidence in the application and continued the case to April 11, 2024, for consideration of a final order by the Commission. Commission staff committed to circulate a draft order based on the proposed findings submitted by the parties in advance of the April 11, 2024 hearing.
