**Stakeholder Notice for Upcoming Invitation to Bid (ITB) Advertisement**  
**June 02, 2026**

The Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department (EMNRD), Oil Conservation Division (OCD), will soon issue an Invitation to Bid (ITB) for a **Statewide Price Agreement for Plugging, Salvage, Assessment, Remediation, Monitoring, Laboratory, and Restoration Services associated with Oil & Gas Wells and Facilities in New Mexico.**

This notice provides advance information to stakeholders and potential bidders regarding the release and key dates associated with the ITB.

**ITB Advertisement Date**

The ITB will be publicly advertised beginning **June 4, 2026**. All bid materials and instructions will be made available on the New Mexico State Purchasing Division (SPD) website and through EMNRD/OCD procurement channels.

**Bid Period**

The solicitation will remain open for **30 days** from the date of advertisement. Bidders are responsible for reviewing all specifications, requirements, and terms outlined in the ITB.

**Pre-Proposal Conference**

A **virtual pre-proposal conference** will be held via Microsoft Teams on **June 11, 2026**. Attendance is strongly encouraged for all prospective bidders, as the OCD will review requirements, answer questions, and clarify elements of the Price Agreement specifications.

A meeting link and instructions for joining the TEAMS session will be provided in the official ITB posting.

**Purpose of the Price Agreement**

This ITB will establish a multi-vendor Statewide Price Agreement supporting OCD's statutory responsibilities, including:

- Plugging and abandonment of oil and gas wells
  - Removal and salvage of surface equipment
  - Environmental assessment and remediation
  - Surface reclamation
- Associated field, technical, and equipment support services (as will be fully detailed in the Price Agreement Specifications.)
