Pursuant to the Surface Waste Management Facilities Rules (19.15.36 NMAC), notice is hereby given that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“Division”) has received a Surface Waste Management Facility permit renewal application, which was submitted to the Division on September 25, 2024:

R360 Permian Basin, LLC (3 Waterway Square Place, Suite 110, The Woodlands, Texas 77380), has submitted a renewal application to the Division for a permit to operate a commercial Surface Waste Management Facility (“Facility”). The Facility will be located approximately 6.25 miles southeast of Maljamar, New Mexico in Section 31 of Township 17 South, Range 33 East and Section 6 of Township 18 South, Range 33 East NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. The Facility will consist of approximately 495 acres which is comprised of a 318 acre oil field waste landfill, and a 177 acre liquid oil field waste Processing Area with 9 produced water load-out points, 12 produced water receiving tanks, 48 produced water settling tanks, 4 mechanical oil/water separation units, 12 evaporation ponds, 1 stabilization/solidification area, 1 oil treating plant, 5 crude recovery tanks, 5 oil sales tanks, 1 customer jet wash station with 6 bays.
