New Email Format for EMNRD-OCD

September 19, 2022

As of Monday, September 19, 2022, the domain for all EMNRD email addresses will be changing from '@state.nm.us' to '@emnrd.nm.gov'. This change is part of a broader migration of all state email accounts by the Department of Information Technology.
