

**REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS
FOR WILDFIRE MAPPING AND WOODSHED ANALYSIS
ISSUED BY THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO,

FORESTRY DIVISION**

The New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department (EMNRD), Forestry Division (Division) is soliciting proposals to establish a contract through competitive negotiations for the procurement of professional services to map wildfire risk, summarize the availability of timber and biomass in priority landscapes aligned with the New Mexico Forest Action Plan (FAP), and map viable locations for wood processing mills and facilities. Services will contribute to a consistent and scalable statewide workflow for reducing wildfire risk and concurrently implementing the New Mexico Biomass Economy Strategy and the 50-Year Water Action Plan.

EMNRD has approximately \$1,000,000.00 available for the work of this Request for Application (RFP).
