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Good morning Carl,

Currently the Annual Camping Pass (ACP) covers the cost of base camping, but not utilities. If the proposals go through and we change rates, any ACPs purchased prior to the change will be honored until their expiration date for the base cost of camping regardless of where it is set. The camper would still be responsible for utility fees, just as they are currently. Those costs may be different depending on the outcome of our process.
