Instructions to Apply for a Concession Permit

BEFORE YOU SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION:

Your application will only be considered for approval if:

- You are in Good Standing with the New Mexico Tax and Revenue Department.
- You are in Good Standing with the New Mexico Secretary of State (if applicable).

FIRST STEPS:

- 1. **Obtain Letters of Good Standing** and attach them to your application:
- New Mexico Tax and Revenue Department: www.tax.newmexico.gov/
- New Mexico Secretary of State:

2. For Sole Proprietors:

- Sole proprietors do not register with the Secretary of State.
- Instead, provide a copy of your County Business License with your application.

3. For Out-of-State LLCs Only:

- Submit a copy of your New Mexico Secretary of State Foreign LLC Good Standing Certificate.

- Filing Fee: \$100 | Processing Time: 30 days

4. Confirm Good Standing:

• Ensure you are in good standing with **both** the New Mexico Tax and Revenue Department and the Secretary of State **before proceeding**.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

1. Complete the Application Form:

- o Do **not** use your Social Security number as your CRS number.
- Use the name registered for your business with the Secretary of State.

2. Provide Proof of Insurance:

- o Include a **Certificate of Insurance** with the following coverage:
 - \$1,000,000 per occurrence
 - \$2,000,000 general aggregate
- o The certificate must name the following as additional co-insured:
 - The State of New Mexico, EMNRD (Energy, Minerals, and Natural Resources Department), The State Parks Division, and *If applicable, the landowner from whom the Division leases the land or reservoir. See the parks list on the next page

Pursuant to 19.5.5.1 NMAC, Concession Permits are valid for one year or less. For outfitters and guides, the Concession Permit's full one-year period is from April 1 until March 31 annually. All other Concession Permits are valid for 12 months from the date of issue, unless otherwise indicated on the Concession Permit. Applicants must submit Concession Permit Applications to the Division Park Superintendent/Manager where the Applicant intends to operate, along with the applicable Concession Permit fee (see 19.5.6 NMAC), and proof of insurance as specified below. Concession Permittees, their employees, and their clients are subject to appropriate local, federal, and state laws, rules, and policies.

By signing below, Applicant certifies Applicant shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless EMNRD, the Division, and the State of New Mexico from all actions, proceedings, claims, demands, costs, damages, attorneys' fees, and all other liabilities and expenses of any kind from any source that may arise from a Concession Permit issued pursuant to this Application, caused by the negligent act or failure to act of the Permittee, its officers, employees, servants, subcontractors, or agents, or if caused by the actions of any client of the Permittee resulting in injury or damage to persons or property during the time when the Permittee or any officer, agent, employee, servant, or subcontractor thereof has or is performing services pursuant to the Concession Permit. In the event that any action, suit, or proceeding related to the services performed by the Permittee or any officer, agent, employee, servant, or subcontractor under the Concession Permit is brought against the Permittee, the Permittee shall, as soon as practicable but no later than two days after it receives notice thereof, notify EMNRD's legal counsel and the Risk Management Division of the New Mexico General Services Department by certified mail. Nothing in this section shall be deemed to be a waiver by the State of New Mexico of the provisions of the Tort Claims Act, NMSA 1978, §§ 41-4-1 et seq.

FEES & INSURANCE

Note: Along with the applicable Concession Permit fee, prior to issuance of a Concession Permit, Applicant shall provide the Division with proof of insurance which shall at a minimum provide a \$1,000,000 limit for each occurrence and a \$2,000,000 general aggregate limit, and shall name the State of New Mexico, EMNRD, and the State Parks Division and if applicable the landowner from which the Division leases the land or reservoir, as additional co-insured.

	Permittee, Permittee's employees, and Permittee's clients shall pay applicable fees associated with a Park's use.
	A permit is valid only within the Park(s) for which it is issued. Exception: Permittee may use a single Concession Permit for:
	 Heron Lake and El Vado Lake State Parks Elephant Butte Lake, Percha Dam, and Caballo Lake State Parks.
	Permits are not transferrable.
	EMNRD must receive applicable fees, good standing letters and proof of insurance before a permit is effective.
	EMNRD has the right to close down a concession operation at any time without prior notice in order to protect the safety and health of Parks, visitors, and staff. <u>NMAC 19.5.5.18</u>
