This increase is not in the best interest in the tax payers of NM. The increase is so high that you will force people to not camp because they can no longer afford it. Camping is currently one of the cost-effective recreation opportunities for people within the state – the increase will take that option away.

The proposed cost increase is comparable to a KOA campground that has wi -fi, pool, laundry facilities and lots of shade. The state parks do not have these amenities.

If the state can afford to pay for funeral costs – they should be able to afford to continue having reasonable camping fees. The use of additional tax dollars from the dispensaries should be used to off set costs for residents.
