I attended the meeting last night at the Navajo Lake State Park. I do not agree with the proposed rate increases. This is what I feel should happen:

Day Use: still charge \$5 per vehicle.

Primitive Camping: \$15 per vehicle.

Developed Camping: \$15 per vehicle

Utilities: \$7 per day (this includes dump station)

Annual Day Pass: \$65

Annual Camping Pass: KEEP - there are a lot of senior citizens that use this pass. It helps them to get out of the house and back into the outdoors. There are a lot of them on fixed incomes that cannot afford the increased rate that you are proposing. If someone violates the rules then they need to be fined, 2 fines would be taking away their annual permit, 3 fines would mean they could never have one again.
