Rio Algom Mining LLC (RAML) respectfully requests a 90-day extension for submittal of the Closure/Closeout Plan (CCP) for the Ambrosia Lake Old Stope Leach Permit, MK009RE. We are submitting this request in response to a letter dated February 13, 2018, in which the Mining and Minerals Division (MMD) and the New Mexico Environmental Department (NMED) required that RAML submit a CCP within 180 days of that date.
