The New Mexico Mining and Minerals Division ("MMD") received a submittal from Dicaperl Minerals Corporation ("Dicaperl") titled, "Site Wide Closeout Plan Updated Application, Response to Closure Cost Comments, Revision Application 16-1, Permit No. SO001RE, Socorro Mine and Mill" ("Application"), dated October 31, 2019. MMD has assigned Revision 19-1 to process this Application.

MMD has conducted a review of the Revision 19-1 Application and hereby deems the application to be administratively complete pursuant to 19.10.5.506.D NMAC. In accordance with 19.10.9.902.I NMAC, Dicaperl shall notify individuals and organizations that have requested notice of applications deemed administratively complete by MMD.
