The New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department, Mining and Minerals Division (MMD) hereby gives notice of a public hearing on the application by Freeport-McMoRan Tyrone Operations (Tyrone), the operator of the Little Rock Mine, for a proposed expansion and to update the closeout plan for the Little Rock Mine. The Little Rock Mine is a copper mine located approximately ten miles south of Silver City near the town of Tyrone, Grant County, New Mexico. MMD's permit number for the mine is GR007RE.
