In preparation for the Section 24 mine reclamation earthwork, several soil samples were collected from the proposed borrow area and analyzed for radium 226 content. This is being performed to ensure that clean alluvial cover material is being used.

A total of thirteen (13) soil samples were collected from the borrow area; with an average radium 226 content of 4.1 picocuries per gram (pCi/g). The maximum concentration of 53.6 pCi/g was located southeast of ventilation hole #2.

A map delineating the borrow area and sampling points, along with the sample results are attached.

From the sampling, it appears that the borrow area will be acceptable for use as cover material with the borrow area modified to ensure that material near ventilation hole #2 is not used.
