Solar Observing

Sat., January 11th, 11AM

Earth is closer to the sun now than in the warmer summer months. The perfect time to learn about the Analemma kiosk and get safe, close-up views of our nearest star with specially-filtered telescopes.

Cochineal: Empire-making insect (Visitor Center, 37 Main St.) Sun., Jan., 26th, 2PM A tiny insect that lives on cactus has been used to make red dye for centuries. Second only to silver as a premium export to Spain, its traditional uses persist to this day. Come find out what they are.

Winter Hike

Did the groundhog see its shadow? Probably. Six more weeks of winter means great conditions in the Cerrillos hills. Come join us on this guided hike.
