

Summary of Rules

1. **Breaking, cutting, defacing, destroying or removing any tree, plant, natural object, park structure or facility is prohibited. Wood gathering is not allowed in Bluewater Lake State Park.**
2. Fishing is allowed in conformity with Game and Fish Regulations and only with a valid fishing license.
3. Vehicle operation and parking are limited to designated roads and established parking areas. Vehicles must obey posted speed limits and not exceed 15 mph at anytime.
4. Pets must be kept on a leash not more than 10 feet long and restrained from loud barking or other behavior which could annoy or present a hazard to wildlife or park visitors. Do not leave pets unattended at the site or in vehicles. Pick up all feces immediately.
5. Swimming is at the swimmer's own risk and is not permitted within 150 feet of a boat ramp, dock, marina, dam or where otherwise prohibited.
6. **Park quiet hours are from 10 pm to 7 am. Use of generators is prohibited during these hours.**
7. A boat's registration number must be printed on each side of the vessel in accordance with New Mexico law, and the certificate of number must be on board when the vessel is in operation.
8. Vessels must be operated at speeds no greater than is reasonable and proper under prevailing conditions. "No Wake" restrictions are strictly enforced where posted and within 150 feet of launch ramps, docks, marinas and mooring areas.
9. **Off Highway Vehicles (OHV) use is prohibited.**
10. **Glass containers are not allowed outside of vehicles, camping units or tents. This applies to all areas of the park.**
11. **No fireworks of any kind permitted.**

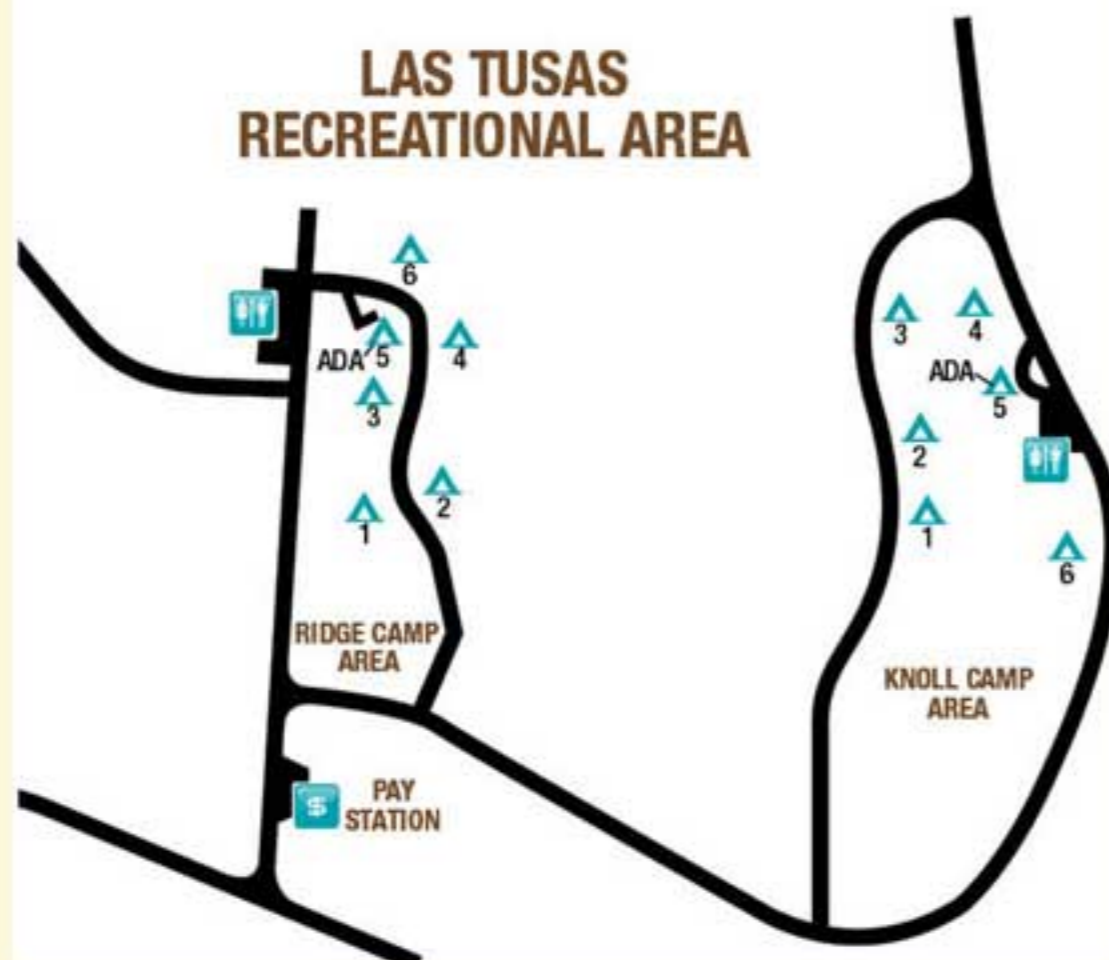
NOTE: This is a partial list of New Mexico State Park Rules. You are responsible to know all rules.

The Zuni Mountains on the continental divide are the main water source for Bluewater Lake State Park. This large and beautiful lake provides a multitude of recreational opportunities including camping, fishing, ice fishing, boating, water skiing, swimming, hiking, bird watching, picnicking and horseback riding. The lake is stocked with rainbow trout, catfish and tiger muskie. Ramps and facilities for the handicapped are also available.

There are restrooms, showers, potable water, dump station, group shelter, shaded picnic shelters, shaded tent camping and RV sites with 30 and 50 amp electric hook-ups and 35 foot and over pull-thrus. Plus two boat ramps and a playground area.

Pets are welcome but must be restrained (See Summary of Rules #4).

We invite you to bring your family and friends and enjoy the spectacular views, relaxing atmosphere and the natural beauty of Bluewater Lake State Park.

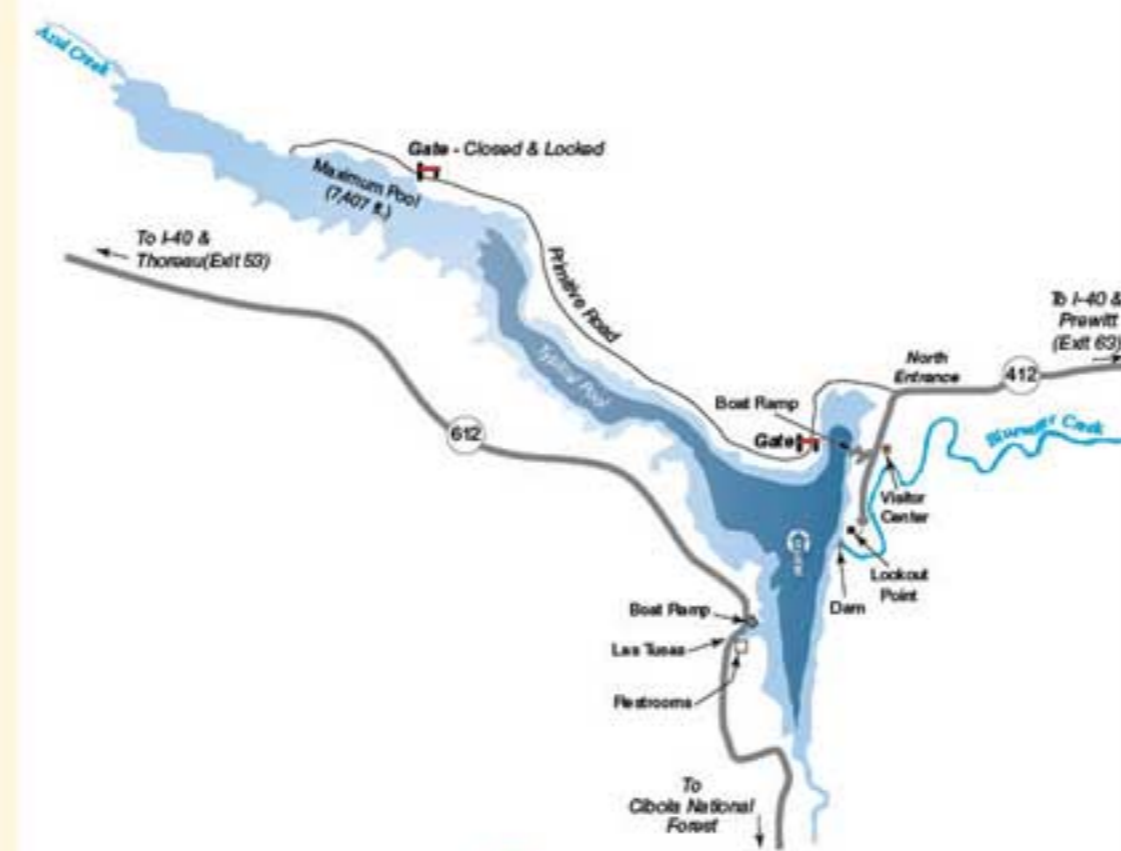
